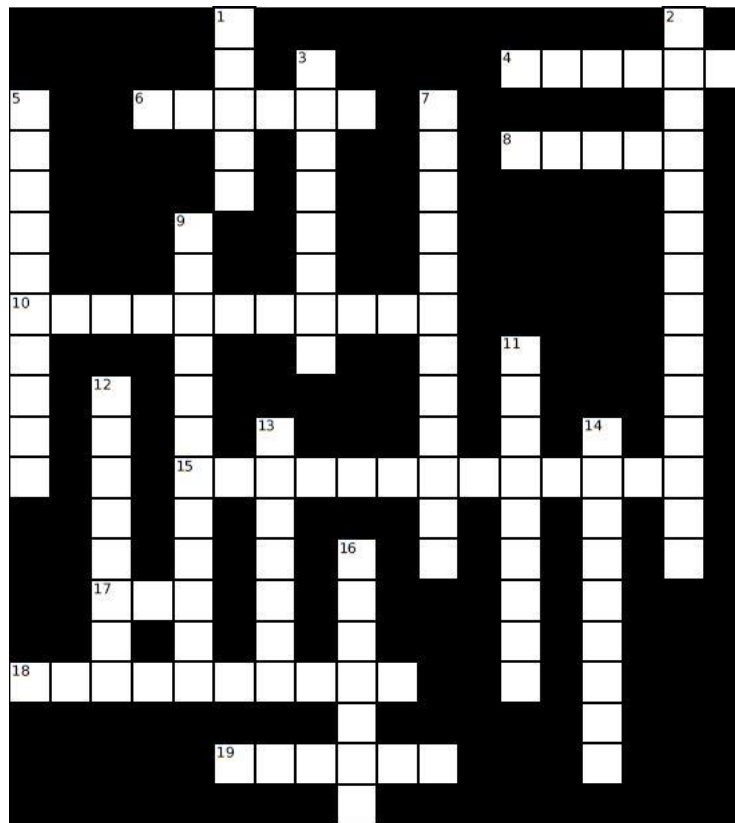


National Civil War Centre Crossword 1
