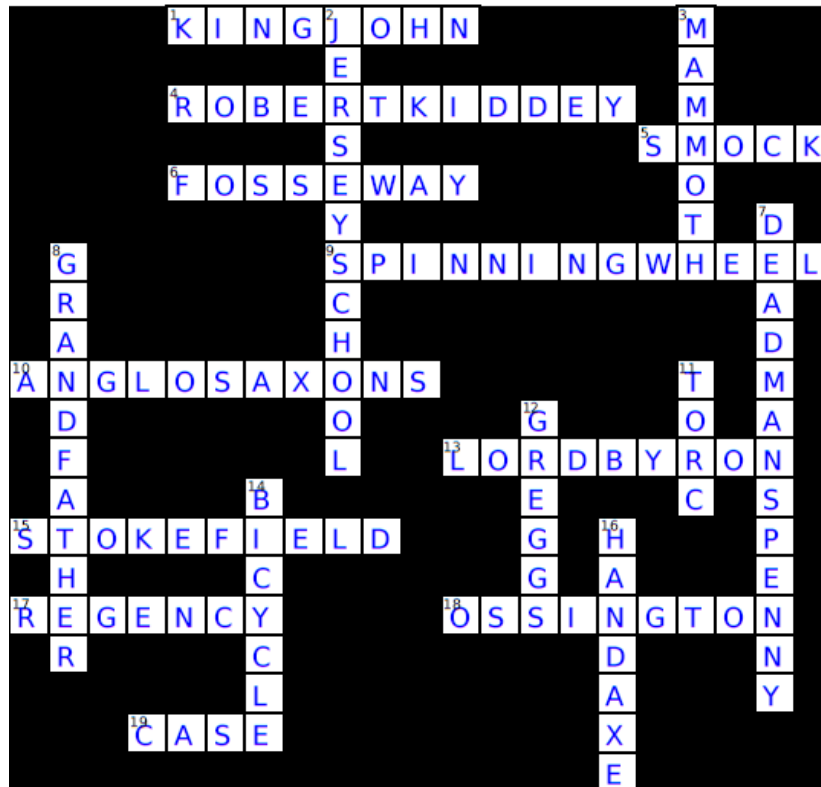


National Civil War Centre Crossword 2
